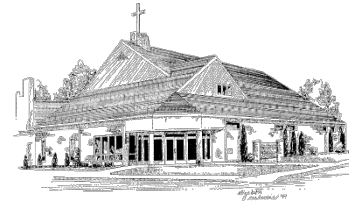



They will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them. Rev. 14:13




1. For all the saints who from their labors rest,




